History

❖ SHORT HISTORY

A Sixth Class State, founded by Kumar Shri Bhaya Nathu Wala, younger son of Darbar Shri Nathu Champraj Wala of Sanala, and hence also known as Bhaya Nathu Estate. The states jurisdictional powers were as follows, Criminal - three months rigorous imprisonment and fines of up to 200Rs, Civil - fines of up to 500Rs. Succession was governed by the rule of equal division. Rulers were....

Darbar Shri BHAYA NATHU WALA, 1st Darbar Saheb of Bhayavadar 1920/-, second son of Darbar Shri Nathu Champraj Wala of Sanala, born 2nd January 1881, succeeded 19th January 1920, educated at Rajkumar College, Rajkot; founded a new village named after himself, Bhayavadar, and resided there.

About Bhayavadar Village

❖ Geography

Bhayavadar is a village panchayat situated in Kunkavav vadia taluka and located in Amreli district of Gujarat. The latitude 21.69363 and longitude 71.3421464 are the geocoordinate of the Bhayavadar. It is located 30 km towards west from District headquarters Amreli. 23 km from . 279 km from State capital Gandhinagar. This Place is on the borders of Amreli and Junagadh Districts.

❖ Demographics

➤ Population Of Bhayavadar :

Bhayavadar is small village with total 310 families residing. The Bhayavadar village has population of 1539 of which 767 are males while 772 are females as per Census 2011 by Indian Government. In Bhayavadar village population of children with age 0-6 is 161 which makes up 10.46% of total population of village. Average Sex Ratio of Bhayavadar village is 1007 which is higher than Gujarat state average of 919. Child Sex Ratio for the Bhayavadar as per census is 851, lower than Gujarat average of 890.

➤ **The official language of Bhayavadar :**

The native language of Bhayavadar is Gujarati and most of the village people speak Gujarati . Bhayavadar people use Gujarati language for communication.

➤ **Bhayavadar Sun rise time :**

Bhayavadar village is located in the UTC 5.30 time zone and it follows indian standard time(IST). Bhayavadar sun rise time varies 44 minutes from IST. The vehicle driving side in Bhayavadar is left, all vehicles should take left side during driving. Bhayavadar people are using its national currency which is Indian Rupee and its international currency code is INR. Bhayavadar phones and mobiles can be accessed by adding the indian country dialing code +91 from abroad. Bhayavadar people are following the dd/mm/yyyy date format in day-to-day life.
